AN ACT

Making an appropriation to the Pennsylvania State College for educational extension work and for maintaining a summer session for teachers

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*
4 *in order to extend the work of the Pennsylvania State*
5 *College to the people of the State along useful and*
6 *practical lines the following sums are hereby specifically*
7 *appropriated for the two fiscal years beginning June first*
8 *one thousand nine hundred and nineteen to the trustees*
9 *of the Pennsylvania State College as they may deem nec-*
10 *essary for the following purposes namely*

11 For meeting the provisions of the act of Congress
12 approved May eight nineteen hundred and fourteen pro-
13 viding for agricultural and home economics extension and
14 for other forms of extension work in agriculture and

1 home economics the sum of three hundred and seventy
2 thousand four hundred and sixty-two dollars (\$370,462)

3 For organizing and maintaining apprentice trade and
4 night schools and classes in co-operation with public
5 school boards boards of trade chambers of commerce in-
6 dustries mining institutes and other institutions and organ-
7 izations and also for public school debating lecture courses
8 reading clubs and other forms of organized educational
9 effort the sum of thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000)

10 For maintaining at the college a summer session for
11 teachers including instruction printing equipment supplies
12 janitor service et cetera the sum of twenty-five thousand
13 dollars (\$25,000)
