AN ACT

To amend section fifty-six of an act approved the twenty-eighth day of July one thousand nine hundred and seventeen (Pamphlet Laws one thousand two hundred fifteen) entitled "An act to revise amend and consolidate the law relating to fish and providing penalties"

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*
4 section fifty-six of an act approved the twenty-eighth day
5 of July one thousand nine hundred and seventeen (Pam-
6 phlet Laws one thousand two hundred fifteen) entitled "An

8 fish and providing penalties" which reads as follows
9 "Section 56 No seine or net shall be licensed for
10 use except a haul seine sometimes called a' shore seine
11 a dip-net or a hold-in net sometimes called a moon rake
12 with a diameter of not more than three feet at the

1 widest point and a length not more than seven feet
2 from the heel of the bow being the point of jointure of
3 the sides of the bow at the handle The meshes of
4 any of the above enumerated seines or nets shall not be
5 less than two and one-half inches stretched fishing measure
6 or one and one-quarter inches from knot to knot while
7 being fished" be and the same is hereby amended to
8 read as follows

9 Section 56 No seine or net shall be licensed for use
10 except a haul seine sometimes called a shore seine a dip-
11 net or a hold-in net sometimes called a moon rake
