AN ACT.

To amend section four hundred and thirty-two and to repeal section four hundred and thirty-seven of an act approved the fourteenth day of July one thousand nine hundred and seventeen (Pamphlet Laws eight hundred forty) entitled "An act concerning townships and revising amending and consolidating the law relating thereto

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*
4 *section four hundred and thirty-two of an act approved*
5 *the fourteenth day of July one thousand nine hundred*
6 *and seventeen (Pamphlet Laws eight hundred forty) entitled*
7 *"An act concerning townships and revising amending and*
8 *consolidating the law relating thereto" which reads as*
9 *follows*

10 "Section 432 Each township of the second class shall
11 receive annually from the State fifty per centum of the

1 total amount of road tax collected by such township as
2 shown by the sworn statement of the board of township
3 supervisors contained in the annual report furnished to the
4 State Highway Commissioner on or before the first day
5 of January in each year. No township shall receive in
6 any one year more than twenty dollars for each mile
7 of township road in said township. Such distribution shall
8 be made on a basis of an average amount to each mile
9 of township road" is hereby amended to read as follows

10 Section 432 Each township of the second class shall
11 receive annually from the State thirty-three and one-third
12 per centum of the total amount of road tax collected
13 by such township as shown by the sworn statement of
14 the board of township supervisors contained in the annual
15 report furnished to the State Highway Commissioner on or
16 before the first day of January in each year. No town-
17 ship shall receive in any one year more than twenty
18 dollars for each mile of township road in said township.
19 Such distribution shall be made on a basis of an aver-
20 age amount to each mile of township road.

21 Section 2 That section four hundred and thirty-seven
22 of said act be and the same is hereby repealed.

23 Section 3 This act shall take effect the first day of
24 January one thousand nine hundred and twenty
