AN ACT

Authorizing the county commissioners of the various counties of this Commonwealth to direct the assessors and assistant assessors of their respective counties to enroll all soldiers sailors and marines who entered the service of the United States from said counties in the war with Germany and compile the service record thereof and authorizing the expenditure of county funds for the foregoing purpose

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*
4 the county commissioners of the several counties of this
5 Commonwealth are hereby authorized to direct the assessors
6 and assistant assessors of their respective counties to en-
7 roll all soldiers sailors and marines who entered the
8 service of the United States in the war with Germany
9 and to compile the service records thereof and to ex-
10 pend such sums as may be necessary to have such en-

1 rollment and service record made and to complete and
2 accurately index and classify said data

3 Section 2 It shall be the duty of the assessors and
4 assistant assessors in this Commonwealth upon receipt of
5 such authorization from the county commissioners together
6 with the necessary books and blanks to enroll every
7 sailor soldier and marine entering the service of the
8 United States from the said assessor's or assistant as-
9 sessor's district in the war with Germany and Austria
10 and to ascertain personally from said soldier sailor marine
11 or his immediate family the service record of said sol-
12 dier sailor or marine together with such other informa-
13 tion as may be required by said county commissioners

14 Section 3 The said enrollment of soldiers sailors and
15 marines together with their service records and other data
16 compiled shall be filed by said assessors and assistant
17 assessors as soon as completed in the office of the county
18 commissioners of the proper county where said records
19 shall be prepared in suitable form and kept open for
20 public inspection by said county commissioners under proper
21 regulations

22 Section 4 The said assessors and assistant assessors
23 when engaged in the enrollment of said soldiers sailors
24 and marines and the compilation of said service record
25 shall receive for the services the same per diem compen-
26 sation to be ascertained in the same way to which they
27 are entitled by law when engaged in the assessment of
28 property or the registration of voters as the case may
29 be

1 Section 5 All acts or parts of acts inconsistent here-
2 with be and the same are hereby repealed
