AN ACT

Relating to and regulating the price and sale of patent
medicine antiseptic cosmetics perfumes toilet soaps in
original packages on which the price is printed and
providing penalties

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*
4 all patent medicines antiseptics cosmetics perfumes toilet
5 soaps in original packages shall have the price thereof
6 printed upon the face thereof in large type

7 Section 2 It shall be unlawful for any person cor-
8 poration co-partnership or association (a) to sell any such
9 patent medicine antiseptics cosmetics perfumes or toilet
10 soaps unless the price thereof is printed on the face of
11 the wrapper or label thereof as required in section one
12 of this act (b) to sell any such patent medicine an-
13 tiseptics cosmetics perfumes or toilet soaps at a price in

1 excess of that printed on the face of the wrapper
2 thereof

3 Section 3 The price list of all patent medicines an-
4 tiseptics cosmetics perfumes and toilet soaps shall be ex-
5 hibited in a conspicuous place in or about any premises
6 where any patent medicine antiseptics cosmetics perfumes
7 and toilet soaps are sold and no deviation in the price
8 shall be made

9 Section 4 Any person corporation co-partnership or as-
10 sociation who shall violate any of the provisions of this
11 act shall upon conviction thereof before any alderman
12 magistrate or justice of the peace of the county be
13 sentenced to pay a fine of not less than fifty dollars
14 (\$50) or more than five hundred dollars (\$500) for each
15 offense or in default thereof such person or persons or
16 the directors or officers or members of such co-partnership
17 association or corporation as the case may be shall be
18 committed to the proper county jail for a period not to
19 exceed thirty days
