AN ACT

To amend part of section eleven of an act approved the second day of February one thousand eight hundred and fifty-four (Pamphlet Laws twenty-one) entitled "A further supplement to an act entitled 'An act to incorporate the city of Philadelphia'"

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same* That
4 so much of section eleven of an act approved the
5 second day of February one thousand eight hundred and
6 fifty-four (Pamphlet Laws twenty-one) entitled "A further
7 supplement to an act entitled 'An act to incorporate the
8 city of Philadelphia'" which reads as follows

9 "Provided that if any person against whom such taxes
10 shall have been assessed shall make affidavit that he did
11 not own the premises for which such taxes were as-
12 sessed at the time they accrued and became a lien
13 thereon the said taxes shall be collected of the true

1 owner thereof or by proceeding to sell the premises by
2 execution And the said receiver of taxes shall furnish
3 certificates of all taxes and claims which are a lien on
4 real estate and receive therefor twenty-five cents for each
5 certificate and five cents for each lien and claim certified"
6 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows
7 Provided that if any person against whom such taxes
8 shall have been assessed shall make affidavit that he did
9 not own the premises for which such taxes were assessed
10 at the time they accrued and became a lien thereon
11 the said taxes shall be collected of the true owner
12 thereof or by proceeding to sell the premises by execu-
13 tion And the said receiver of taxes shall furnish cer-
14 tificates of all taxes and claims which are a lien on
15 real estate and receive therefor fifty cents for each cer-
16 tificate and five cents for each lien and claim certified
