AN ACT

To fix the salaries of clerks in the Bureau of Searches under the Receiver of Taxes in cities of the first class

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*
4 *from and after the passage of this act councils in cities*
5 *of the first class in this Commonwealth shall fix the*
6 *salaries of clerks in the Bureau of Searches under the*
7 *Receiver of Taxes as follows to wit the salary of the*
8 *chief clerk shall not be less than two thousand dollars*
9 *(\$2,000) per annum and the salaries of the other clerks*
10 *shall not be less than one thousand five hundred dollars*
11 *(\$1,500) each per annum payable semi-monthly in the man-*
12 *ner as now provided by law.*

13 Section 2 All acts and parts of acts inconsistent here-
14 with are hereby repealed
