## AN ACT

To amend section four of an act approved the fifteenth day of April one thousand nine hundred and fifteen (Pamphlet Laws one hundred thirty-two) entitled "An act relative to the burial of the bodies of certain indigent deceased widows at the county expense"

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*  
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*  
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*  
4 *section four of an act approved the fifteenth day of*  
5 *April one thousand nine hundred and fifteen Pamphlet*  
6 *Laws one hundred thirty-two) entitled "An act relative to*  
7 *the burial of the bodies of certain indigent deceased*  
8 *widows at the county expense" which reads as follows*  
9 "Section 4 The county commissioners may draw their  
10 warrant upon the county treasurer in favor of the per-  
11 sons whose duty it is to bury the body of any such

1 indigent deceased widow for the payment of the expenses  
2 necessarily incurred in such burial not exceeding the said  
3 sum of fifty dollars for each body so buried" be and  
4 the same is hereby amended to read as follows  
5 Section 4 The county commissioners may draw their  
6 warrant upon the county treasurer in favor of the per-  
7 sons whose duty it is to bury the body of any such  
8 indigent deceased widow for the payment of the expenses  
9 necessarily incurred in such burial not exceeding the said  
10 sum of seventy-five dollars for each body so buried
