AN ACT

To amend section one of the act approved the twentieth day of May one thousand nine hundred thirteen (Pamphlet Laws two hundred sixty-four) entitled "An act relating to assessments for taxes in townships of the first class in this Commonwealth fixing the compensation of assessors and assistant assessors in such townships extending the time within which the said assessors are required to complete their assessment and make their return thereof and further providing for the determination of the time actually employed by the said assessors and assistant assessors in the performance of their duties"

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*
4 *section one of the act approved the twentieth day of May one*
5 *thousand nine hundred thirteen (Pamphlet Laws two hundred sixty-*

2 ships of the first class in this Commonwealth fixing the
3 compensation of assessors and assistant assessors in such
4 townships extending the time within which the said as-
5 sessors are required to complete their assessment and
6 make their return thereof and further providing for the
7 determination of the time actually employed by the said
8 assessors and assistant assessors in the performance of
9 their duties" which reads as follows

10 "Section 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House
11 of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in
12 General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the
13 authority of the same That the assessor in each town-
14 ship of the first class in this Commonwealth shall re-
15 ceive as compensation for his services ten (\$10) dollars
16 per diem for each day actually employed by him in the
17 performance of the duties of his office both in making
18 the triennial assessment and in making the supplemental
19 assessments in the intervening years between the years of
20 the triennial assessment the said compensation to be paid
21 by the county as heretofore The compensation of the
22 assistant assessors in the said townships of the first class
23 shall be five (\$5) dollars per diem for each day actually
24 employed by them respectively in the performance of the
25 duties of their office to be paid by the county as here-
26 tofore" is hereby amended to read as follows

1 "Section 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House
2 of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in
3 General Assembly met and it is hereby enacted by the
4 authority of the same That the assessor in each town-
5 ship of the first class in this Commonwealth shall re-
6 ceive as compensation for his services ten (\$10) dollars
7 per diem for each day actually employed by him in the
8 performance of the duties of his office both in making
9 the triennial assessment and in making the supplemental
10 assessments in the intervening years between the years of
11 the triennial assessment the said compensation to be paid
12 by the county as heretofore The compensation of the as-
13 sistant assessors in the said townships of the first class
14 shall be seven dollars (\$7) per diem for each day actually
15 employed by them respectively in the performance of the
16 duties of their office to be paid by the county as
17 heretofore
