## AN ACT

Authorizing the Insurance Commissioner to revoke the certificate of authority of and to refuse admission to companies or associations from any state which refuses to permit like companies or associations organized and operating under the laws of this State to do a like business in said state and designating who may and who may not make examination of said companies or associations and providing who shall pay the expenses of examinations of such companies or associations

1 Section 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-*  
2 *sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly*  
3 *met and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same That*  
4 *whenever the Insurance Department of any state refuses*  
5 *authority to do business to any life fire marine accident*  
6 *liability casualty fidelity or surety company or association*  
7 *chartered and operating under the laws of this Common-*

1 wealth the Insurance Commissioner is authorized to pro-  
2 hibit all such companies or associations from such state  
3 from doing a like business in the State of Pennsylvania

4 Section 2 That whenever any Insurance Department of  
5 another state requires an examination of any life fire ma-  
6 rine accident liability casualty fidelity or surety company  
7 or association chartered and operating under the laws of  
8 this Commonwealth doing business within said state or  
9 having made application for admission to do business  
10 therein said department shall have the right to examine  
11 such company or association of this State said examina-  
12 tions to be made by a regularly appointed examiner of  
13 said state who is not employed regularly or from time  
14 to time by any state excepting that one requiring the  
15 examination or by any life fire marine accident liability  
16 casualty fidelity or surety company or association and the  
17 expenses of said examination shall be borne by the state  
18 making the same Provided however That the valuation  
19 made or accepted by the Insurance Department of this  
20 State upon property located within this State shall be  
21 accepted by said examiner for the state making such ex-  
22 aminations

23 Section 3 All acts or parts of acts inconsistent here-  
24 with are hereby repealed
