AN ACT

Amending the act of April 10 1867 (P L 62) entitled "An act for the better and more impartial selection of persons to serve as jurors in each of the counties of this Commonwealth" requiring the selection of jurors to be made from a receptacle containing the names of all qualified electors

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

5 Section 2 It shall be the duty of said jury commissioners presi-
6 dent judge or additional law judge of the respective district or a majority
7 of them to meet at the seat of justice of the respective counties at least
8 thirty days before the first term of the court of common pleas in every
9 year and thereupon proceed with due diligence to select alternatively
10 from a receptacle containing the names of the whole qualified electors
11 of the respective county at large a number such as at the term of the
12 court of pleas next preceding shall by the said court be designated of
13 sober intelligent and judicious persons to serve as jurors in the several
14 courts of such county during that year and the said jury commissioners
15 president judge or additional law judge or a majority of them shall in
16 the mode and manner now directed by law place the names of persons
17 so selected in the proper jury wheel and the said jury wheel locked
18 as now required by law shall remain in the custody of the said jury
19 commissioners and the keys thereof in the custody of the sheriff of
20 said county
