AN ACT

Requiring bills introduced in the General Assembly to be printed with
punctuation

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows

- 1 Section 1 Bills introduced in the General Assembly shall be printed
- 2 with all punctuations that are on the original bill as introduced
- 3 Section 2 The Secretary of the Commonwealth shall not after a
- 4 bill has been enacted into law make any change in punctuation therein

EXPLANATION—CAPITAL LETTERS indicate new matter added to bill. Matter stricken through is to be omitted from bill.
Underscoring indicates new matter added to existing law. [Brackets] indicate matter stricken from existing law.

3 Section 3 The provisions of this act shall not be construed to repeal
