AN ACT

Amending the act of May 25 1945 (P L 1050) entitled "An act relating to the collection of taxes levied by counties county institution districts cities of the third class boroughs towns townships certain school districts and vocational school districts conferring powers and imposing duties on tax collectors courts and various officers of said political subdivisions and prescribing penalties" further regulating compensation of tax collectors in boroughs and townships of the second class

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

1 Section 1 Section 35 act of May 25 1945 (P L 1050) known as
2 the "Local Tax Collection Law" is amended to read

3 Section 35 Compensation of Tax Collector in Boroughs and Town-
4 ships of the Second Class The tax collector in boroughs and townships
5 of the second class shall receive as compensation for the collection of
6 county institution district borough and township taxes salary wages or
7 a commission on all such taxes to be fixed by the respective taxing
8 authorities levying such taxes not exceeding five per centum of the
9 amount collected In the case of school district taxes the commission
10 or compensation of the tax collector shall be determined by the board
11 of school directors and the total cost of such collection shall be reported
12 annually to the Superintendent of Public Instruction and shall be pub-
13 lished in his report

14 For the collection of county institution district school district bor-
15 ough and township taxes the tax collector shall be allowed by the re-
16 spective taxing authorities actual and needful expenditures for printing
17 postage books blanks and forms
