AN ACT

Amending the act of May 4 1927 (P L 519) entitled "An act concern-
ing boroughs and revising amending and consolidating the law
relating to boroughs" providing that applicants for the position
of policeman and fireman need not be residents of the borough
and authorizing residence to be required after appointment as
police and firemen

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania here-
by enacts as follows

3 1621) is amended to read

4 Section 1179 Age Applicants Residence No person shall be eligible
5 to apply for examination unless he is more than twenty-one years of
6 age at the date of application [and has been a resident of the borough
7 for at least one year preceding immediately his application unless no
8 such resident applicants are available] An applicant need not be a
9 resident of the borough The council of the borough may authorize the
10 commission by rule or regulation to require police and firemen to
11 become residents of the borough after appointment to such positions
