## AN ACT

Amending the act of May 4 1927 (P L 519) entitled "An act concerning  
boroughs and revising amending and consolidating the law relating  
to boroughs" authorizing disturbing the peace to be defined  
and penalized and providing for disposition of such penalties

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby  
enacts as follows

1 Section 1 Clause LV of section 1202 act of May 4 1927 (P L 519)  
2 known as "The Borough Code" reenacted and amended July 10 1947  
3 (P L 1621) is amended to read

4 Section 1202 Specific Powers The powers of the borough shall be  
5 vested in the corporate officers They shall have power

7 LV [Disorderly Conduct] Disturbing the Peace Ordinances To  
8 adopt ordinances defining [disorderly conduct] disturbing the peace  
9 within the limits of the borough and to provide in such ordinances for  
10 the imposition of penalties for the violation thereof [Notwithstanding]  
11 notwithstanding like statutes pertaining to the same or similar offenses  
12 All penalties imposed for the violation of such ordinances shall be paid  
13 to the borough treasurer for the use of the borough

15 Section 2 This act shall take effect immediately
