AN ACT

Authorizing the Department of Property and Supplies with the approval of the Governor to acquire a tract of land with buildings improvements and antiques and other personal property therein in the Borough of Brownsville Fayette County for preservation care and maintenance as a historical site by the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

EXPLANATION—CAPITAL LETTERS indicate new matter added to bill. Matter stricken through is to be omitted from bill. Underscoring indicates new matter added to existing law. [Brackets] indicate matter stricken from existing law.

1 Section 1 The Department of Property and Supplies with the ap-
2 proval of the Governor is hereby authorized to purchase in the name of
3 the Commonwealth a certain tract of land from the estate of Mrs Charles
4 Bowman in the Borough of Brownsville Fayette County Pennsylvania
5 with the buildings and improvements thereon known as "Bowman's
6 Castle" covering approximately four acres and including such antiques
7 and other personal property on the premises as shall be agreed upon by
8 the seller and the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission

9 Section 2 The tract of land improvements and personal property
10 when purchased shall be under the jurisdiction of the Pennsylvania
11 Historical and Museum Commission for preservation care and mainten-
12 ance as a historical site The deed of conveyance shall be deposited with
13 the Secretary of Internal Affairs the land shall not be acquired until the
14 title thereto has been approved by the Department of Justice

15 Section 3 So much as shall be necessary but not in excess of Twenty
16 Thousand Dollars (\$20,000) is hereby appropriated to the Department
17 of Property and Supplies for the payment of the purchase price of the
18 land buildings improvements and personal property and expenses inci-
19 dental thereto

20 Section 4 This act shall take effect immediately
