**AN ACT**

Amending the act of May 22 1933 (P L 851) entitled "An act fixing the pay and mileage of jurors and witnesses" further providing for the mileage of jurors when such jurors are temporarily sent home

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

1 Section 1 Section 1.1 act of May 22 1933 (P L 851) entitled "An  
2 act fixing the pay and mileage of jurors and witnesses" amended  
3 December 21 1959 (P L 1971) is amended to read

4 Section 1.1 Every juror shall be paid mileage at the rate of seven  
5 cents for each mile he actually travels in going to such place from his  
6 place of residence and returning but not for a greater number  
7 of miles than would be required for traveling by the usually-traveled  
8 route between those places Every juror who is sent home by the court  
9 but ordered to return at a later date shall also be paid mileage at the  
10 above rate for such additional trip or trips to and from his place of  
11 residence
