AN ACT

Amending the act of November 19 1959 (PL 1548) entitled "An act to provide temporary supplemental retirement benefits for certain annuitants of the Public School Employees' Retirement System creating a special fund in the custody of the State Treasurer imposing duties on the Public School Employees' Retirement Board and making an appropriation" making the receipt of benefits permanent and including disability annuitants

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

13 Section 1 Any former contributor to the Public School Employes'
14 Retirement System who is in receipt of a superannuation retirement
15 allowance as of January 1 1960 and any contributor to the Public School
16 Employes' Retirement System whose superannuation retirement shall
17 become effective [during the period] after January 1 1960 [to May
18 31 1961] shall be entitled to receive a supplemental State annuity [dur-
19 ing the period] beginning January 1 1960 or date of superannuation
20 retirement whichever is later [and ending May 31 1961] and any for-

1 mer contributor to the Public School Employees' Retirement System
2 who is in receipt of a disability allowance as of June 1 1961 and any
3 contributor to the Public School Employees' Retirement System whose
4 disability retirement shall become effective after June 1 1961 shall
5 be entitled to receive a supplemental State annuity beginning June 1
6 1961 or date of disability retirement whichever is later Such supple-
7 mental State annuity shall be equivalent to the amount by which the
8 superannuation retirement allowance prior to any optional modification
9 or the disability allowance prior to any optional modification to which
10 he is entitled under the laws governing the Public School Employees'
11 Retirement System is less than fifty dollars (\$50) for each year of
12 credited service Provided however That the sum of (a) the retirement
13 allowance prior to optional modification or the disability allowance prior
14 to optional modification payable under the laws governing the Public
15 School Employees' Retirement System (b) any social security old age
16 or disability insurance benefit (primary insurance amount) attributable
17 to service as a school employe and (c) the supplemental State annuity
18 shall not exceed one thousand eight hundred dollars (\$1800) per year
19 Section 4 For the purposes of this act the sum of three million
20 three hundred thousand dollars (\$3,300,000) is hereby appropriated for

- 1 the period January 1 1960 to May 31 1961 An additional sum of one
- 2 million eight hundred thousand dollars (\$1,800,000) is appropriated
- 3 for the fiscal period June 1 1961 to May 31 1962
