A JOINT RESOLUTION

Proposing an amendment to article two section three of the Constitu-
tion of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania by providing for
six-year terms for senators and four-year terms for representatives

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby resolves as follows

- 1 Section 1 The following amendment to the Constitution of the
- 2 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with the
- 3 provisions of the eighteenth article thereof

1 That section three article two of the Constitution of the Com-
2 monwealth of Pennsylvania be amended to read

3 Section 3 Senators shall be elected for the term of six years and
4 representatives for the term of four years except that at the first gen-
5 eral election after the effective date of this amendment one-half of the
6 representatives shall be elected for terms of four years and one-half for
7 terms of two years as shall be provided for by act of the General
8 Assembly
