AN ACT

Amending the act of August 9 1955 (P L 323) entitled "An act relating to counties of the third fourth fifth sixth seventh and eighth classes amending revising consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto" authorizing the closing of court houses and other county offices on Saturdays in counties of the third class

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

1 Section 1 The act of August 9 1955 (P L 323) known as "The
2 County Code" is amended by adding after section 2301 a new section
3 to read

4 Section 2301.1 Saturday Closing in Third Class Counties In
5 counties of the third class the county commissioners may order that
6 the county court house and all county offices located elsewhere be
7 closed all day on Saturdays throughout the year or during any specified
8 period of the year

9 Section 2 This act shall take effect immediately.
