**AN ACT**

Amending the act of April 12 1951 (P L 90) entitled "An act relating to alcoholic liquors alcohol and malt and brewed beverages amending revising consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto regulating and restricting the manufacture purchase sale possession consumption importation transportation furnishing holding in bond holding in storage traffic in and use of alcoholic liquors alcohol and malt and brewed beverages and the persons engaged or employed therein defining the powers and duties of the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board providing for the establishment

and operation of State liquor stores for the payment of certain license fees to the respective municipalities and townships for the abatement of certain nuisances and in certain cases for search and seizure without warrant prescribing penalties and forfeitures providing for local option and repealing existing laws" providing for the issuance of retail store malt and brewed beverage licenses

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

- 1 Section 1 The act of April 12 1951 (P L 90) known as the "Liquor
- 2 Code" is amended by adding after section 433 a new section to read
- 3 Section 433.1 Retail Store Malt and Brewed Beverage Licenses
- 4 The board may issue retail store malt and brewed beverage licenses to
- 5 any store primarily engaged in the business of selling groceries which
- 6 license will permit such stores to sell malt and brewed beverages for
- 7 consumption off the premises during the hours during which holders
- 8 of distributors' licenses may sell Applicants for retail store licenses
- 9 shall meet all the requirements of this act for distributors and the fee
- 10 for such licenses shall be the same as for retail dispensers' licenses The

- 1 board shall have the power to suspend or revoke any such licenses for
- 2 cause after the granting of a hearing thereupon to the licensee Appeals
- 3 shall be as provided by this act for other licensees
