AN ACT

Amending the act of August 9 1955 (P L 323) entitled "An act relating to counties of the third fourth fifth sixth seventh and eighth classes amending revising consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto" requiring audits of certain funds in the hands of county officers and employes from miscellaneous sources

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

4 Section 1721.1 Audits of Miscellaneous Funds and Accounts It
5 shall also be the duty of the controller or county auditors to audit
6 settle and adjust the accounts of county officers and employes of the
7 county with respect to moneys received by them (1) as advancements
8 of or as security for the payment of costs from parties to any court
9 proceedings (2) for the purpose of transmittal thereof to parties entitled
10 thereto in cases involving domestic relations and nonsupport and (3)
11 from for and on behalf of patients in county institutions
