AN ACT

Amending the act of August 9 1955 (P L. 323) entitled "An act relating to counties of the third fourth fifth sixth seventh and eighth classes amending revising consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto" by correcting the name of the Italian American War Veterans of the United States Incorporated to conform with name in charter

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

4 Section 2362 Plan of Hall Special Rooms to be Provided

5 (a) Such memorial hall shall be in honor of the soldiers sailors
6 and marines from said county who served in the Army and Navy of
7 the United States in any war in which the United States has been or
8 may hereafter be engaged Such memorial halls shall each contain one
9 large assembly room or auditorium for public meetings of the soldiers
10 sailors and marines of such county which may be used also for other
11 public meetings and patriotic gatherings by the consent of the board
12 of control herein provided for

13 (b) Such memorial hall shall also contain rooms for meetings of
14 Posts of the Grand Army of the Republic encampments of the Union
15 Veterans Legion commanders of the Loyal Legion camps of the Sons
16 of Veterans Women's Relief Corps Ladies of the Grand Army of the
17 Republic chapters of the Daughters of the Revolution the American
18 Gold Star Mothers Inc Organizations of the Spanish-American War
19 and Philippine Insurrection the American Legion Veterans of Foreign
20 Wars Italian American [World] War Veterans of the United States

1 Incorporated Disabled American Veterans Military Order of the Purple
2 Heart and organizations of veterans of all other wars in which the
3 United States has or may be engaged and also rooms for meetings of
4 ladies' auxiliaries of posts encampments camps and organizations for
5 which rooms for meetings may be contained in the memorial hall and
6 also rooms for such committees of public defense and welfare as may
7 be created by the Commonwealth or as may be approved by the board
8 of control hereinafter provided for

9 (c) Such memorial halls shall also provide room for the display
10 and preservation of relics and trophies of all wars in which the United
11 States has been or may be engaged photographs paintings and portraits
12 busts and statues of the soldiers sailors and marines of the said counties
13 and mural tablets upon which shall be inscribed the names of such
14 soldiers sailors and marines Such memorial halls shall also contain wait-
15 ing and rest rooms with laboratories attached
