**AN ACT**

Amending the act of June 23 1931 (P L 932) entitled "An act relating to cities of the third class and amending revising and consolidating the law relating thereto" changing the name of the Italian American World War Veterans of the United States Incorporated to conform with its charter

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

1        Section 1 Clause 34 of section 2403 act of June 23 1931 (P L

17 and to each post of the Jewish War Veterans and to each organization  
18 of American Gold Star Mothers and to each post of the Italian Ameri-  
19 can [World] War Veterans of the United States Incorporated and to  
20 any other such organization of ex-service men in the city incorporated

1 under the laws of the Commonwealth a sum not to exceed three hun-  
2 dred dollars to aid in defraying the expenses of Memorial Day and  
3 Armistice Day Where the Grand Army of the Republic has ceased  
4 to exist or to function such appropriation may be made to the Sons  
5 of Union Veterans of the Civil War or in the absence of such order  
6 to a duly constituted organization which conducts the decorating of  
7 the graves of Union veterans of the Civil War Such payments shall  
8 be made to defray actual expenses only Before any payment is  
9 made the organization receiving the same shall submit verified accounts  
10 of their expenditures
