AN ACT

Amending the act of May 15 1874 (P L 186) entitled "An act declaring
what offices are incompatible" making the office of mayor of
third class cities and members of the legislature incompatible

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows

4 of the legislature to hold or to exercise the office of mayor in any city
5 of the third class or councilman in any incorporated city of this common-
6 wealth
