AN ACT

Amending the act of April 12 1951 (P L 90) entitled "An act relating to alcoholic liquors alcohol and malt and brewed beverages amending revising consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto regulating and restricting the manufacture purchase sale possession consumption importation transportation furnishing holding in bond holding in storage traffic in and use of alcoholic liquors alcohol and malt and brewed beverages and the persons engaged or employed therein defining the powers and duties of

the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board providing for the establishment and operation of State liquor stores for the payment of certain license fees to the respective municipalities and townships for the abatement of certain nuisances and in certain cases for search and seizure without warrant prescribing penalties and forfeitures providing for local option and repealing existing laws" providing for the ordering and sale of miniature bottles to certain licensees

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

1 Section 1 Section 305 act of April 12 1951 (P L 90) known as the
2 "Liquor Code" is amended by adding at the end thereof a new subsection
3 to read

4 Section 305 Sales by Pennsylvania Liquor Stores

5 * * *

6 (h) Every Pennsylvania Liquor Store shall accept orders for and
7 sell miniature bottles of such class varieties and brands of liquor as the
8 board shall prescribe Such bottles shall be ordered for and sold only to
9 those persons possessing a hotel restaurant club or public service liquor
10 license together with a miniature bottle permit

1 Section 2 Section 401 of the act is amended by adding at the end
2 thereof a new subsection to read

3 Section 401 Authority to Issue Liquor Licenses to Hotels Restau-
4 rants and Clubs * * *

5 (c) The board shall issue to any hotel restaurant club or public
6 service licensee who pays in addition to his regular license fee an an-
7 nual permit fee of one hundred dollars (\$100) a miniature bottle per-
8 mit which shall authorize such licensee to order and purchase miniature
9 bottles of liquor at designated Pennsylvania Liquor Stores The purchase
10 and sale of such miniature bottles by the licensee shall be subject to the
11 same provisions of this act and any rules and regulations promulgated
12 thereunder that regulate the purchase and sale of liquor by said licensees
13 The permit fee provided for herein shall be collected by the board for its
14 use in defraying the costs involved in handling the miniature bottles at
15 the Pennsylvania Liquor Stores and warehouses Nothing herein con-
16 tained shall require the stores to stock miniature bottles

17 Section 3 This act shall take effect immediately
