AN ACT

Amending the act of April 12 1951 (P L 90) entitled "An act relating to alcoholic liquors alcohol and malt and brewed beverages amending revising consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto regulating and restricting the manufacture purchase sale possession consumption importation transportation furnishing holding in bond holding in storage traffic in and use of alcoholic liquors alcohol and malt and brewed beverages and the persons engaged or employed therein defining the powers

and duties of the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board providing for the establishment and operation of State liquor stores for the payment of certain license fees to the respective municipalities and townships for the abatement of certain nuisances and in certain cases for search and seizure without warrant prescribing penalties and forfeitures providing for local option and repealing existing laws" prohibiting the refilling of any liquor bottle or other liquor container

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

7 (10) Fortifying Adulterating or Contaminating Liquor For any
8 licensee or any employe or agent of a licensee or of the board to
9 fortify adulterate or contaminate any liquor except as permitted by
10 the regulations of the board or to refill wholly or in part with any

1 liquid or substance whatsoever any liquor bottle or other liquor con-
2 tainer [bearing the official seal of the board]
