AN ACT

duties of the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board providing for the establishment and operation of State liquor stores for the payment of certain license fees to the respective municipalities and townships for the abatement of certain nuisances and in certain cases for search and seizure without warrant prescribing penalties and forfeitures providing for local option and repealing existing laws" further regulating license fees and default in the payment of such fees

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

1 Section 1 Section 405 act of April 12 1951 (P L. 90) known as
2 the "Liquor Code" is amended by adding at the end thereof a new
3 subsection to read

4 Section 405 License Fees * * *

5 (d) Whenever any checks issued in payment of filing and/or license
6 fees shall be returned to the board as dishonored the board shall charge
7 a fee of five dollars (\$5.00) per hundred dollars or fractional part thereof
8 plus all protest fees to the maker of such check submitted to the board
9 Failure to pay the face amount of the check in full and all charges

- 1 thereon as herein required within ten days after demand has been made
- 2 by the board upon the maker of the check the license of such person
- 3 if issued shall immediately terminate and be cancelled without any
- 4 action on the part of the board
