A JOINT RESOLUTION

Proposing an amendment to article nine of the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania exempting personal taxes of retired persons over the age of sixty-five from the requirement of uniformity

6 levied and collected by the Commonwealth or by political subdivisions
7 thereof under laws which provide for graduated rates and exemptions
