AN ACT

Making an appropriation to the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum
Commission to aid in the maintenance and operation of a shrine
to house the replica of the Liberty Bell

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows

- 1 Section 1 The sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) or as much
- 2 thereof as may be necessary is hereby appropriated for the fiscal period
