**AN ACT**

Amending the act of March 10 1949 (P L 30) entitled "An act relating to the public school system including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools amending revising consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto" providing permanent certification for certain persons teaching in private institutions

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

4 Section 1205 Issuing Permanent College Certificates The Super-  
5 intendent of Public Instruction shall issue a permanent college cer-  
6 tificate to every graduate of a college or university approved by the  
7 State Council of Education and of such departments therein as are  
8 approved by him when such graduate furnishes satisfactory evidence  
9 of good moral character and successful experience of three years' teach-  
10 ing on a provisional college certificate in the public schools of this  
11 Commonwealth in private institutions [from which the Department of  
12 Public Instruction purchases services on a tuition basis] and in state-  
13 aided and state-owned secondary schools and has completed such work  
14 in education as may be approved by the State Council of Education  
15 Such certificate shall entitle its holder to teach without further  
16 examination
