**AN ACT**

Prescribing the courts in which actions against officers or agencies of  
the Commonwealth may be instituted

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
hereby enacts as follows

- 1 Section 1 Any action in which the head of an executive or ad-  
2 ministrative department a departmental board or commission an inde-  
3 pendent administrative board or commission or any other officer or in-  
4 strumentality of the Commonwealth other than a political subdivision  
5 thereof is a party defendant may be brought either in the Court of
