AN ACT

Amending the act of April 12 1951 (P L 90) entitled "An act relating to alcoholic liquors alcohol and malt and brewed beverages amending revising consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto regulating and restricting the manufacture purchase sale possession consumption importation transportation furnishing holding in bond holding in storage traffic in and use of alcoholic liquors alcohol and malt and brewed beverages and the persons engaged or employed therein defining the powers and duties of the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board providing for the estab-

lishment and operation of State liquor stores for the payment of certain license fees to the respective municipalities and townships for the abatement of certain nuisances and in certain cases for search and seizure without warrant prescribing penalties and forfeitures providing for local option and repealing existing laws" excepting certain clubs from the quota limitations

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

1 Section 1 Section 461 act of April 12 1951 (P L 90) known as
2 the "Liquor Code" amended August 11 1959 (P L 670) and Decem-
3 ber 17 1959 (P L 1932) is amended by amending subsection (a) and
4 adding at the end thereof a new subsection to read

5 Section 461 Limiting Number of Retail Licenses To Be Issued
6 In Each Municipality (a) No licenses shall hereafter be granted by
7 the board for the retail sale of malt or brewed beverages or the retail
8 sale of liquor and malt or brewed beverages in excess of one of such
9 licenses of any class for each one thousand five hundred inhabitants
10 in any municipality exclusive of licenses granted to airport restaurants
11 and hotels and veterans' clubs as defined in this section and clubs but
12 at least one such license may be granted in each municipality except in

1 municipalities where the electors have voted against the granting of
2 any retail licenses Nothing contained in this section shall be construed
3 as denying the right to the board to renew or to transfer existing retail
4 licenses of any class notwithstanding that the number of such licensed
5 places in a municipality shall exceed the limitation hereinbefore pre-
6 scribed but where such number exceeds the limitation prescribed by
7 this section no new license except for hotels and airport restaurants
8 and veterans' clubs as defined in this section shall be granted so long
9 as said limitation is exceeded

11 (e) "Veteran's club" as used in this section shall mean any branch
12 post camp or chapter of a veteran's organization nationally organized
13 and organized by the United States Government or any agency thereof
14 or any nonprofit incorporated home association of a branch post camp
15 or chapter whose entire membership is the same as the branch post
16 camp or chapter
