AN ACT

Making an appropriation to the Trustees of The Academy of Natural Sciences of Philadelphia to be used for salaries supplies and equipment and in providing certain services and facilities to the public and to students at all levels interested in scientific studies and research

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

- 1 Section 1 The sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) is
- 2 hereby specifically appropriated to The Academy of Natural Sciences
