AN ACT

Amending the act of July 28 1953 (P L 723) entitled "An act relating to counties of the second class amending revising consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto" providing for payments into the county retirement fund by county employes for periods of employment by authorities created by counties of the second class

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

1 Section 1 Section 1710 act of July 28 1953 (P L 723) known as
2 the "Second Class County Code" is amended by adding at the end there-
3 of a new subsection to read

4 Section 1710 Employees Eligible for Retirement Allowances

5 * * *

6 (h) Any county employe who shall have been previously employed by
7 an authority created by counties of the second class shall have his or her
8 previous length of employment with that said authority or authorities
9 credited for all purposes under this act Provided That said employe
10 shall pay into the retirement fund an amount equal to the amount he
11 or she would have been required to pay had such employe been a mem-
12 ber of the retirement fund during the terms of his or her previous em-
13 ployment together with the principal amount the said authority or
14 authorities would have been required to pay into the retirement fund
15 had the said authority or authorities been subject to the provisions of
16 this act during the term of the employe's previous employment The
17 said aggregate principal amount to be paid by such an employe shall
18 be paid into the retirement fund in full as a condition precedent to the
19 employe being eligible to receive the benefits of the retirement allow-
20 ance

- 1** Section 2 This act shall take effect the first day of the month
- 2** following its enactment
