AN ACT

Amending the act of June 24 1939 (P L 872) entitled "An act to consolidate amend and revise the penal laws of the Commonwealth" changing the name of the Italian American World War Veterans of the United States Incorporated to conform with its charter

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows
