**AN ACT**

Amending the act of July 8 1941 (P L 208) entitled "An act authorizing the creation of and providing for and regulating the maintenance and operation of a county employes' retirement system in counties of the fourth class imposing certain charges on counties and fixing penalties" authorizing counties to increase their share of certain members monthly allowance

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

EXPLANATION—CAPITAL LETTERS indicate new matter added to bill. Matter stricken through is to be omitted from bill. Underscoring indicates new matter added to existing law. (Brackets) indicate matter stricken from existing law.

1 Section 1 The act of July 8 1941 (P L 298) known as the "Fourth  
2 Class County Retirement Law" is amended by adding after section 17  
3 a new section to read

4 Section 17.1 Increase of County Share for Certain Employees

5 (a) When the board has adopted the one eightieth (1/80) class the  
6 county may in the case of an employe who has retired or who retires  
7 in the future and has his monthly allowance calculated under the one  
8 one-hundredth (1/100) class increase their share of such employes  
9 monthly allowance by twenty-five percent (25%) and in the case of an  
10 employe who has his allowance calculated under the one one-hundred-  
11 twentieth (1/120) class increase their share of such employes monthly  
12 allowance by fifty percent (50%)

13 (b) When the board has not adopted the one eightieth (1/80) class  
14 but only has the one one-hundredth (1/100) and one one-hundredth-  
15 twentieth (1/120) class the county may in the case of an employe who  
16 has retired or who retires in the future and has his monthly allowance  
17 calculated under the one one-hundredth-twentieth (1/120) class increase  
18 their share of such employes monthly allowance by twenty percent  
19 (20%)

1        (c) The amount of the employes monthly allowance received under  
 2        the provisions of this section shall be limited as to the extent that such  
 3        employe's combined social security and retirement benefits for any one  
 4        year shall not exceed eighty percent (80%) of his average salary for  
 5        the five highest years
