**AN ACT**

Amending the act of August 5 1941 (P L 803) entitled as amended "An act providing for the creation maintenance and operation of a county employes' retirement system in counties of the fifth sixth seventh and eighth class imposing certain charges on counties and prescribing penalties" authorizing counties to increase their share of certain members monthly allowance

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

1 Section 1 The act of August 5 1941 (P L 803) entitled as amended  
2 "An act providing for the creation maintenance and operation of a  
3 county employees' retirement system in counties of the fifth sixth seventh  
4 and eighth class imposing certain charges on counties and prescribing  
5 penalties" reenacted and amended May 2 1940 (P L 881) is amended  
6 by adding after section 16 a new section to read

7 Section 16.1 Increase of County Share for Certain Employees

8 (a) When the board has adopted the one eightieth (1/80) class  
9 the county may in the case of an employe who has retired or who re-  
10 tires in the future and has his monthly allowance calculated under the  
11 one one-hundredth (1/100) class increase their share of such employes  
12 monthly allowance by twenty-five percent (25%) and in the case of an  
13 employe who has his allowance calculated under the one one-hundred-  
14 twentieth (1/120) class increase their share of such employes monthly  
15 allowance by fifty percent (50%)

16 (b) When the board has not adopted the one eightieth (1/80) class  
17 but only has the one one-hundredth (1/100) and one one-hundred-  
18 twentieth (1/120) class the county may in the case of an employe who  
19 has retired or who retires in the future and has his monthly allowance

- 1 calculated under the one one hundred-twentieth (1/120) class increase
- 2 their share of such employes monthly allowance by twenty percent
- 3 (20%)
- 4 (c) The amount of the employes monthly allowance received under
- 5 the provisions of this section shall be limited as to the extent that such
- 6 employe's combined social security and retirement benefits for any
- 7 one year shall not exceed eighty percent (80%) of his average salary
- 8 for the five highest years
