AN ACT

Amending the act of June 1 1933 (P L. 1172) entitled "An act establishing certain streets in boroughs and incorporated towns as State highways and providing for their construction and maintenance at the expense of the Commonwealth" adding a new route in the Borough of Masontown Fayette County

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

6 Masontown Borough

7 Route . Beginning at the intersection of Main Street and
8 Church Street thence in a westerly direction over Main Street to its
9 intersection with River Avenue thence over River Avenue in a north-
10 westerly direction to its intersection with Pennsylvania Highway Route
11 21 a distance of about 1.3 miles in the Borough of Masontown Fayette
12 County

13 Section 2 The highway established as a State highway under the
14 provisions of this act may be taken over for construction and main-
15 tenance at any time subsequent to the final enactment of this act
16 when the same shall become effective and shall be taken over not later
17 than January 1 1962
