AN ACT

Amending the act of June 1 1933 (P L 1172) entitled "An act establishing certain streets in boroughs and incorporated towns as State highways and providing for their construction and maintenance at the expense of the Commonwealth" changing a route in the Borough of Masontown Fayette County

7 Route 26079 Extending Route 26079 Beginning at a point on
8 the Masontown Borough-German Township line thence in a northwest-
9 erly direction on Fairview Street to South Water Street thence in a
10 northerly direction on South Water Street to an intersection with
11 [Route 26008 at South Water and Church Streets] Sterling Street
12 thence in a westerly direction on Sterling Street to its intersection
13 with Legislative Route 166 in the Borough of Masontown Fayette
14 County a distance of about [0.26] 0.76 of a mile

15 Section 2 The highway established as a State highway under the
16 provisions of this act may be taken over for construction and main-
17 tenance at any time subsequent to the final enactment of this act when
18 the same shall become effective and shall be taken over not later than
19 January 1 1962
