AN ACT

Authorizing arraignments in courts of quarter sessions of the peace and
courts of oyer and terminer and general jail delivery

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows

- 1 Section 1 Courts of quarter sessions of the peace and courts of
- 2 oyer and terminer and general jail delivery may by rule of court provide
- 3 for arraignment of defendants in cases triable in such courts
