AN ACT

Making an appropriation to the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum
Commission for the repair and restoration of the Caleb Pusey
House subject to certain conditions

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows

- 1 Section 1 The sum of thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000) or as
- 2 much thereof as may be necessary is hereby specifically appropriated
- 3 to the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission to be expended

- 1 by said commission for the repair and restoration of the historic Caleb
- 2 Pusey House in the Borough of Upland Delaware County Pennsylvania
- 3 Section 2 The moneys hereby appropriated shall be available and
- 4 expended only at such time as a sum equal to the amount hereby appro-
- 5 priated by the Commonwealth is contributed to the trustees of the Caleb
- 6 Pusey House by local historical societies associations or similar organiza-
- 7 tions or by individuals to be used for the repair and restoration of the
- 8 said Caleb Pusey House and upon further condition that one or more
- 9 local historical societies associations or similar organizations shall cove-
- 10 nant with said trustees to thereafter preserve and maintain the Caleb
- 11 Pusey House in a good state of repair Affidavits evidencing such contri-
- 12 butions and covenants shall be submitted by said trustees to the Auditor
- 13 General
