AN ACT

Authorizing the Department of Public Welfare with the approval of the Board of Trustees of the Connellsville State Hospital to contract with the City of Connellsville and the Connellsville Municipal Authority for construction improvements and extensions to the sewerage collection system and treatment plant and the use thereof by the Connellsville State Hospital and the payment of part of the cost and maintenance thereafter and making an appropriation

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

1 Section 1 The Department of Public Welfare with the approval of
2 the Board of Trustees of the Connellsville State Hospital is hereby
3 authorized to enter into a contract with the City of Connellsville and
4 the Connellsville Municipal Authority for construction improvements
5 and extensions to the sewerage collection therewith and the use thereof
6 by the Connellsville State Hospital and for the future payment of the
7 Commonwealth of a proportionate part of the cost of maintenance of
8 such sewage disposal plant

9 Section 2 The sum of one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000)
10 or as much thereof as may be necessary is hereby appropriated to the
11 Department of Public Welfare for the payment of the Commonwealth's
12 share of the cost of the construction improvements and extensions of
13 such sewage disposal plant

14 Section 3 This act shall take effect immediately
