A SUPPLEMENT

To the act of April 1 1863 (P L 213) entitled "An act to accept the grant of public lands by the United States to the several states for the endowment of agricultural colleges" making and appropriation for carrying the same into effect

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

EXPLANATION—CAPITAL LETTERS indicate new matter added to bill. Matter stricken through is to be omitted from bill. Underlining indicates new matter added to existing law. (Brackets) indicate matter stricken from existing law.

1 Section 1 In order to carry into effect the act of Congress approved
2 July 2 1862 granting public land to the several states for educational
3 purposes and subsequent acts of Congress related thereto and the act of
4 the Legislature of Pennsylvania approved April 1 1863 and subsequent
5 acts of the Legislature of Pennsylvania accepting the provisions and
6 conditions of said acts of Congress and pledging the faith of the State
7 to carry the same into effect the sum of twenty-three million one hun-
8 dred thirteen thousand fourteen dollars (\$23,113,014) or as much
9 thereof as may be necessary is hereby specifically appropriated to the
10 trustees of the Pennsylvania State University for the fiscal period June
11 1 1961 to June 30 1962 for the following purposes

12 (1) For the general maintenance of instruction research and ex-
13 tension in the College of Agriculture the Mont Alto Forest School
14 Branch the College of Business Administration the College of Chem-
15 istry and Physics the College of Education the college of Engineering
16 and Architecture the College of Home Economics the College of the
17 Liberal Arts the College of Mineral Industries the College of Physical
18 Education and Athletics the Graduate School the Continuing Educa-
19 tion Services and for the general maintenance of other schools depart-
20 ments offices and services including repairs and improvements to the

1 grounds and buildings service of light heat power water and sewage
2 disposal salaries and wages materials supplies equipment books and
3 periodicals insurance and interest and such other expenditures as the
4 trustees may deem necessary and practicable the sum of twenty-two mil-
5 lion eight hundred twenty thousand seven hundred fourteen dollars (\$22,-
6 820,714)

7 (2) For the purpose of carrying on research and investigation to
8 discover by-products of anthracite and bituminous coal and uses there-
9 for of developing new scientific chemical industrial domestic and other
10 uses and new and extended markets for anthracite coal and its prod-
11 ucts and for employing engineers chemists technical experts assistants
12 clerks stenographers and other employes and purchasing such machinery
13 supplies equipment apparatus and other things necessary in the further-
14 ance of the aforesaid research and investigation to be used by the Col-
15 lege of Mineral Industries under the supervision of the State Depart-
16 ment of Mines and Mineral Industries the sum of thirty-seven thousand
17 eight hundred dollars (\$37,800) The moneys appropriated by this clause
18 shall be available and expended only to the extent that a sum equal
19 to fifty per centum of the amount to be expended by the Commonwealth

1 is contributed to the Pennsylvania State University by the members
2 of the anthracite and bituminous coal industry Affidavits evidencing such
3 contributions shall be submitted by the University to the Auditor Gen-
4 eral

5 (3) For the purpose of matching money contributed by industry
6 to the College of Mineral Industries for research and investigation of
7 long-range problems affecting the mineral industries the sum of thirty-
8 one thousand fifty dollars (\$31,050) No more shall be expended from
9 this item than may be required to match an equal sum contributed to
10 the University by one or more industries for such research and investi-
11 gation Affidavits evidencing such contributions shall be submitted by
12 the University to the Auditor General

13 (4) The support of research and investigation of basic problems
14 affecting the slate and other nonmetallic mineral industries the sum
15 of eighteen thousand nine hundred dollars (\$18,900)

16 (5) For the support of research and investigation of long-range
17 basic problems affecting the mineral industries the sum of seventeen
18 thousand five hundred fifty dollars (\$17,550)

19 (6) For the use of the College of Agriculture for expenditure by
20 the Agricultural Experiment Station for the support of research and

1 investigation directed toward the development and production of su-
2 perior strains of crops and livestock to develop more efficient meth-
3 ods of producing and marketing such products the sum of eighty-one
4 thousand dollars (\$81,000)

5 (7) For the maintenance and the support of research and experi-
6 mental investigation on problems relating to the petroleum industry
7 of the State the sum of fifty-four thousand dollars (\$54,000)

8 (8) For the use of the College of Agriculture for expenditure by
9 the Agricultural Experiment Station for the erection of experimental
10 mushroom houses and research in the communicable diseases of mush-
11 rooms and other phases of the mushroom industry the sum of twenty-
12 five thousand dollars (\$25,000)

13 (9) For the use of the College of Agriculture for expenditure by
14 the Agricultural Experiment Station for research and investigation of
15 mastitis in dairy cattle the sum of twenty-seven thousand dollars (\$27,-
16 000)
