AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10 1949 (P L 30) entitled "An act relating to the public school system including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools amending revising consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto" providing for the payment of office expenses of the county superintendent by county board of school directors

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

1 Section 1 Sections 1039 1040 and 1041 act of March 10 1949
2 (P L 30) known as the "Public School Code of 1949" are amended to
3 read

4 Section 1039 County Board of School Directors to Furnish Office
5 Rooms etc The county [commissioners of each county] board of school
6 directors of the several school districts entitled under this act to services
7 provided through the office of the county superintendent shall provide
8 furnish and maintain fit and suitable office rooms at the county-seat for
9 the use of the county superintendent of schools and his assistants if any
10 [The county commissioners] Such board of school directors shall also
11 provide furnish and maintain safe and suitable storage in connection with
12 such office rooms for the preservation and safekeeping of the school
13 records books and documents pertaining to such office They shall also
14 provide for the use of the superintendent and assistant superintendents
15 all necessary stationery printing blanks and postage other than that
16 connected with the annual county teachers' institute The cost of such
17 facilities and supplies shall be apportioned among the school districts in
18 that proportion which the number of students in average daily attend-
19 ance in each such district bears to the total number of students entitled
20 to the services of the county superintendent

1 Section 1040 Telephone Typewriter and Stenographer Furnished by
2 County In each county the county superintendent of schools may be
3 provided at the expense of the county board of school directors of the
4 several school districts entitled under this act to services provided
5 through the office of the county superintendent with a telephone a
6 typewriter and a stenographer In counties having more than three
7 hundred (300) teachers in the public schools the stenographer may be
8 employed by the year In counties having less than three hundred (300)
9 teachers in the public schools the stenographer shall be employed for at
10 least two days of each week or the equivalent of such time during the
11 year

12 The stenographer may be chosen by the superintendent and the
13 compensation shall be fixed by the superintendent [and county com-
14 missioners and shall be paid out of the county treasury]

15 Section 1041 Telephone Typewriter and Stenographic Services in
16 Counties Second Class In each county of the second class the county
17 superintendent of schools may be provided at the expense of the county
18 board of school directors of the several school districts entitled under
19 this act to services provided through the office of the county superin-

1 tendent with such telephone typewriter and stenographic services as
2 may be needed Such stenographer or stenographers may be chosen by
3 the superintendent and their compensation shall be fixed by the super-
4 intendent [and county commissioners and shall be paid out of the
5 county treasury]
