AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10 1949 (P L 30) entitled "An act relating to the public school system including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools amending revising consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto" prohibiting the purchase of insurance from or through any person employed by the school district in a teaching or administrative capacity

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

4 Section 513 Group Insurance Contracts (a) Any school district
5 may make contracts of insurance with any insurance company or non-
6 profit hospitalization corporation or nonprofit medical service cor-
7 poration authorized to transact business within the Commonwealth
8 insuring its employes or any class or classes thereof under a policy
9 or policies of group insurance covering life health hospitalization
10 medical service or accident insurance and may contract with any
11 such company granting annuities or pensions for the pensioning of
12 such employes and for such purposes may agree to pay part or all of
13 the premiums or charges for carrying such contracts and may appro-
14 priate out of its treasury any money necessary to pay such premiums
15 or charges or portions thereof No contract or contracts of insurance
16 authorized by this section shall be purchased from or through any
17 person employed by the school district in a teaching or administrative
18 capacity

8 fire insurance company authorized to transact business in this Com-

13 have full power and authority to make and enter into any contract
14 or contracts it may deem proper with any person firm or corporation
15 including any mutual insurance company authorized to transact busi-
16 ness in this Commonwealth for the purpose of insuring every employe
17 of the school district against liability for damages sustained by pupils
18 or others as a result of the employes' negligence in the performance
19 of his or her duties during the course of his or her employment

1 (c) No contract or contracts of insurance authorized by this sec-
2 tion shall be purchased from or through any person employed by the
3 school district in a teaching or administrative capacity
