AN ACT

Amending the act of April 9 1929 (P L 177) entitled "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the Executive Department thereof and the administrative departments boards commissions and officers thereof including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools or Teachers Colleges abolishing creating reorganizing or authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative departments boards and commissions defining the powers and

duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative officers and of the several administrative departments boards commissions and officers fixing the salaries of the Governor Lieutenant Governor and certain other executive and administrative officers providing for the appointment of certain administrative officers and of all deputies and other assistants and employes in certain departments boards and commissions and prescribing the manner in which the number and compensation of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of certain departments boards and commissions shall be determined" prescribing a minimum period of time for assistance payments to be made by the State Veterans Commission

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

1 Section 1 Subsection (d) of section 1411 act of April 9 1929 (P L
2 177) known as "The Administrative Code of 1929" amended November
3 10 1959 (P L 1468) is amended to read

4 Section 1411 State Veterans Commission The State Veterans Com-
5 mission shall have the power and its duty shall be

1 (d) To expend funds appropriations to or for it for the purpose
2 of providing the necessities of life and to otherwise assist such Penn-
3 sylvania veterans of any war or armed conflict or the widows and infant
4 children or dependents of such veterans as are sick disabled or indigent
5 and who are without means for planning and providing for the re-
6 habilitation and care of veterans

7 Such expenditures shall be made for the stated purposes in accord-
8 ance with rules regulations and standards established by the State
9 Veterans Commission In no event shall payments made by the State
10 Veterans Commission exceed the maximum assistance payable under the
11 "Public Assistance Law" nor shall such payments be made for a period
12 of less than one hundred and twenty days to any veteran widow child or
13 dependent

14 Section 2 This act shall take effect immediately
