AN ACT

Amending the act of June 9 1911 (P L 736) entitled "An act making appropriations to institutions not wholly managed by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania liens on the premises of such institutions for the use of the Commonwealth and providing for the collection thereof" limiting the terms of such liens to twenty years

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

1 Section 1 Section 6 act of June 9 1911 (P L 736) entitled "An act

6 Section 6 Such appropriation shall be a non-interest bearing [liens]
7 lien on said real estate for the term of twenty years from the date of
8 such entry of said [certificates] certificate in said [dockets] docket and
9 in case of public or private sale of such real estate during that term
10 shall be paid out of the proceeds thereof before any subsequent liens
11 mortgage encumbrance or other charge

12 Section 2 The act is amended by adding after section 9 a new
13 section to read

14 Section 9.1 If the institution corporation or unincorporated associa-
15 tion shall utilize said real estate and erections constructions and other
16 permanent improvements aforesaid for the purpose for which the appro-
17 priation was made for the term of twenty years from the date of entry
18 of said certificate in said docket and shall so certify to the prothonotary
19 upon affidavit of the chief officer of said institution corporation or un-

1 incorporated association the prothonotary shall mark said lien as satis-
 2 fied in full upon said docket and indices The institution corporation or
 3 unincorporated association shall pay the prothonotary the sum of five
 4 dollars for satisfaction of said lien
