AN ACT

Making an appropriation to the Department of Public Welfare for
the maintenance of certain hospitals

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows

- 1 Section 1 The sum of twenty-eight million one hundred forty-four
- 2 thousand eight hundred thirty dollars (\$28,144,830) or as much thereof
- 3 as is necessary is appropriated to the Department of Public Welfare
- 4 for the fiscal period of thirteen months beginning June 1 1961 to be

1 by it paid to the hospitals hereinafter designated in the amounts here-
 2 inafter specified for the purpose of the maintenance of such hospitals
 3 in accordance with the rules and regulations issued by the Department
 4 of Public Welfare and the Department of the Auditor General as pre-
 5 scribed by law at the rate of fifteen dollars (\$15) per diem for the medi-
 6 cal and surgical services rendered to and maintenance of persons treated
 7 in the hospital who are entitled to free service but not to exceed the
 8 actual cost to the hospital of such services and maintenance and all
 9 moneys received on account of the care of the patient shall be reported
 10 as a credit against the gross earnings of free and part pay service charge-
 11 able against this appropriation

8 Section 2 Any unexpended balance of the appropriation as deter-

9 mined by the Department of the Auditor General shall be allocated by

10 the Department of Public Welfare and the Department of the Auditor

11 General among the hospitals the amounts for which herein specified

12 have not been sufficient to pay for the services rendered by them to

13 persons entitled to free service in the proportion which the total amount

14 to which each hospital is entitled under the formulae set forth in section

15 1 hereof and for which it has not been paid bears to the total of such

16 amounts of all the hospitals that have not been paid in full The amount

17 allocated to any hospital shall not be greater than the amount to which

18 the hospital is entitled under the formulae set forth in section 1 All

19 amounts so allocated shall be paid by the department to the hospitals en-

20 titled thereto in the manner prescribed by law

1 Section 3 Except in cases of accident or emergency only bonafide
 2 residents of Pennsylvania shall be entitled to the free service provided
 3 for in this act

4 Section 4 All participating hospitals shall file a report with the
 5 Department of the Auditor General within ninety days of the last day
 6 of each quarter Failure to file the report timely as required hereunder
 7 shall disqualify the institution from receiving an appropriation for the
 8 quarter covered by the untimely filed report
