A JOINT RESOLUTION

Proposing an amendment to article four section twenty-one of the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania changing the time at which the Auditor General the State Treasurer and the Secretary of Internal Affairs take office and permitting the Auditor General and State Treasurer to succeed themselves for one additional term

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby resolves as follows

EXPLANATION—CAPITAL LETTERS indicate new matter added to bill. Matter stricken-through is to be omitted from bill. Underscoring indicates new matter added to existing law. (Brackets) indicate matter stricken from existing law.

1 Section 1 The following amendment to the Constitution of the
2 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with the
3 provisions of the eighteenth article thereof

4 That section twenty-one article four of the Constitution of the
5 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania be amended to read

6 Section 21-A The terms of the Srecretary of Internal Affairs the
7 Auditor General and the State Treasurer shall each be four years and
8 shall begin on the third Tuesday of January next following their election
9 and they shall be chosen by the qualified electors of the State at general
10 elections

11 Section 21-B Except for the Auditor General and State Treasurer
12 who may be in office when this amendment is adopted they shall be
13 eligible to succeed themselves for one additional term

14 Schedule

15 That no inconvenience may arise from the change in the Consti-
16 tution of the Commonwealth and in order to carry it into complete
17 operation it is declared that

18 The Auditor General the State Treasurer and the Secretary of
19 Internal Affairs who may be in office when this amendment is adopted

1 shall serve until the end of their respective terms for which elected The
 2 term of the Auditor General the State Treasurer and the Secretary
 3 of Internal Affairs first elected after this amendment is adopted or
 4 who is elected at the same election at which this amendment is adopted
 5 shall begin at the end of the term of the Auditor General the State
 6 Treasurer and the Secretary of Internal Affairs then in office.

7 Plan of Advertising

8 and Submission to Voters

9 Section 21-A and section 21-B shall each be advertised separately
 10 and each shall be voted upon separately
